### 2022-2023 EESA Breakfast and Lunch Update

This letter is to inform you that Elevated Excellence Academy will start charging for **Breakfast and Lunch** for students who have not completed and returned a School Lunch Application for the School year 2022/2023. **The deadline for Lunch Applications will be February 24, 2023.** After the deadline students with no application will be charged the breakfast price will be \$1.29 and the lunch cost will be \$3.56

In the event that a student does not have a positive balance, the student may charge up to 10 meals to their account. Only reimbursable meals may be charged. A la carte items may not be charged. Communication about a negative meal balance will be sent to parents/guardians via email. Students who have exceeded the 10 charged meal limit, will be offered an alternative meal that will be charged to the student's account up to 6 alternative meals. After the 6 alternative meals have been exhausted and the balance owed is not paid in full you are subject to have the account go to our collections department.

Please make sure that the Lunch applications are returned to the school by the due date to Ensure that students can continue to take part in the school's breakfast and lunch program.
